Introduction

The City of Launceston invites the community, as custodians of our heritage to nominate places they deem to be of local heritage significance.

This nomination form is an identification resource only and maintains no statutory implications for the development of a place, including addition to the Launceston local heritage list. All nominations are subject to assessment by a City of Launceston Heritage Officer.

When should this form be used?

Please use this form to nominate a local heritage place, local heritage precinct, local historic landscape precinct, place or precinct of archaeological potential, or significant tree that you feel could be included within the Launceston Local Provisions Schedule (local heritage list) of the Tasmanian Planning Scheme.

The Launceston Local Provisions Schedule is a statutory list that provides legal recognition and protection for the conservation and management of locally significant heritage items and precincts within the Launceston municipality.

When should this form not be used?

This form should not be used to nominate an item or precinct of:

- State heritage significance (please visit Heritage Tasmania via <u>www.heritage.tas.gov.au</u> to find out how to nominate a state heritage item), or
- Local heritage significance located outside the Launceston municipality (Please contact your local council for further information on listing locally significant items or precincts outside the Launceston municipality).

What information is required?

Before completing this form, please confirm the following information:

- Is the item or precinct already listed on the local or state heritage register?
- Is the item or precinct of local heritage significance to the Launceston municipality?
- Does the item or precinct meet at least one of the local significance criteria as set out within the Tasmanian Planning Scheme State Planning Provisions (Section C6.3)?
 - Local history
 - Creative or technical achievement
 - A class of building or place
 - Aesthetic characteristics
 - Association with a particular community or cultural group for social or spiritual reasons.
 - Association with the life or works of a person, or groups of persons, of importance to the locality or region.
